



**UAW LOCAL 148
STRIKE DUTY INSTRUCTIONS**

All members must participate in a strike activity in order to be eligible for strike assistance. The Local Union Strike Committee will assign your strike activity to you. **It is your obligation to contact the Strike Committee for the time and date of your strike assignment.** Participation may be picket duty, kitchen duty, strike information classes, or any other strike related assignment. You must be in good standing at the time of the strike to receive benefits.

IF YOU HAVE NOT YET RECEIVED YOUR PICKET ASSIGNMENT PLEASE CONTACT YOUR UNION.

In order to qualify for your first strike assistance check, **YOU MUST REGISTER ON THE DAY AND TIME ASSIGNED:**

At the time of registration, we will also be processing a form for insurance coverage. Please have your Social Security Number, Seniority Date, and the dates of birth of family members, eligible for coverage to complete this form.

Your first check will be issued on MAY25th, for A-D FROM 9am TO 12:30pm and E-Le from 1:30p.m. to 5:00p.m. and MAY 26th for Li-Ri FROM 9am TO 12:30PM and Ro-Z FROM 1:30PM TO 5:00PM at UAW 148 at the above address. YOUR CHECK MUST BE PICKED UP ON YOUR SCHEDULED DAY AND TIME, OR YOU WILL LOSE IT!

When you register for benefits, you will be issued a picket card and your picket captain will indicate on the card when you have completed your strike duty. You must sign in when reporting for picket duty. **You must present your picket card at Strike Headquarters to receive your benefit check on THAT DATE. DO NOT LOSE YOUR PICKET CARD! IT MEANS STRIKE ASSISTANCE FOR YOU.**

Any member eligible for strike benefits preceding the termination of the strike will receive a back to work check. **Strike Assistance is taxable! To avoid problems, keep a record of all assistance you receive.**
