Because of the economic impact on the community and region created by the ongoing labor dispute between United Auto Workers Local 148 and the Boeing Co. in Long Beach, CA, the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service, an independent agency of the United States government, is hereby convening a meeting of the parties with the goal of taking further steps to resolve the dispute.
